



ALL SAINTS' DIOCESAN SCHOOL TEZPUR

SCHOOL REPORT NOVEMBER 2019 - MARCH 2020

Programmes and Activities:

1. The new academic session commenced from the 1st April 2019 followed by the other non-scholastic activities of the school. The students have completed their Periodic Test - I in the month of June 2019 and Term End - I Examination in September 2019.
2. A Teachers, Workshop was organised on 25th May 2019 by an experienced web designer and teacher Mrs. Kala J, SSB Campus, Tezpur on efficient Classroom Management and Teaching.
3. A Students' Talent Assessment Examination was conducted by the North East Institute for Talent Search Examination on 5th June 2019 in Tezpur Govt. Girls' School. Three successful students from ASDST viz. L. Margherita Devi of Class V, Aditya Borgohain of Class VI and Nandita Devi of Class VIII will get scholarship from the State government.
4. The foundation and a plaque for the new School Building was laid by the Bishop of DNEICNI, Rt. Rev. Michael Herenz on 6th August 2019. All the Presbyters of the diocese, the members of the School Managing Committee and the parents and the students of the school were present for the solemn occasion. It was a milestone in the history of the school. Tree plantation programme followed after the Ground-breaking ceremony. A get-together lunch was also served.
5. A Computer Science Laboratory furnished with 10 computers (Dell) has been completed in the month of August 2019 and is skillfully maneuvered by two well-experienced teachers – Ms. Manjuri Swargiary and Mr. Subrata Sarkar.

6. The boundary problem between the All Saints' Diocesan School Office and the All Assam Tribal Sangha Office has been amicably settled by the Mandals, Circle Office, Tezpur by the actual measurement of land and on mutual understanding on 20th Sept. 2019.
7. The Provisional Permission to open a new school has been granted to ASDST by the office of the Inspectors of Schools, Sonitpur District.
8. The application for NOC from the State government for the purpose of affiliation to CBSE is submitted to the Planning Officer, I.S.Office Sonitpur district. Follow-up work to be done.
9. The permission for a transformer has been granted by the Tezpur Municipal Corporation and it was submitted to the Assam State Electricity Board for further action. The work has to be pursued since there is frequent power-cut in the campus.
10. A new submersible water pump was installed for the second time on 21st Oct. 2019 for providing sufficient water in the school campus.
11. The new school building work (RCC) started in the campus on 14th Nov. 2019 after procuring the Permission Letter from Tezpur Municipal Corporation.
12. The old school office was demolished on 30th Nov. 2019 at about 6:30 p.m. So the school office was shifted temporarily to the Wyld's Cottage.
13. A Teachers' Meeting was organised where the Treasurer, Dr. Paul Petta and Mr. Jiten Gogoi, the Administrator gave important instructions and guidance to the teachers. The need for Montessori Play Items (Slide and Seasaw), one desktop for Examination purpose, five more desktops , a LCD Projector and A. C. for the Computer Science Lab., the need for Science teachers , a Physical Instructor and a Counsellor were raised.
14. A Drawing Competition was organised by the Tea Board of India on the theme: "Communal Harmony" for the students classes I to VIII. Dr. Amrita Chakrabarty, Assistant Director, Tea Board , Tezpur and the Staff were present to encourage the students. They also distributed the prizes to the winners.
15. A Parents' Meeting was organised in ASDST on 7th Dec. 2019. The Chairman, the Secretary, the Treasurer and the Administrator were present for the meeting. The Chairman welcomed the Executive members and the parents, the Secretary led the opening prayer and the Principal gave a brief school report. The parents shared their views and ideas for the welfare of the students and the school.
16. The Periodic Test - II (2019-20) commenced from 3rd Dec. 2019 to 10th Dec. 2019. The school remained closed for the Winter Vacation from 16th Dec. 2019 to 3rd Jan. 2020.

17. The Annual Sports Week was held in the school from 27th Jan to 30th Jan. 2020. The winners were given the medals and the certificates on 8th Feb.2020.
18. The TERM END - II (2019-20) was held from 5th March 2020 to 12th March 2020. Prior to this, the revision of the lessons were done.
19. The Results of Term End - II (2019-20) could not be given virtually on 20th March 2020, since the government declared nation-wide lockdown for the COVID-19 Pandemic. So the results were mailed to the parents.
