Primary Years/Preparatorys

Our Primary level starts from **Class 3 to 5** (8 years onwards) after a comfortable transformation from the colourful world of kindergarten to an equally colourful world of primary learning. At primary level a lot of absorption, observation, retention, questioning, reinforcement and controlled practice takes place. This stage is immensely important, as it is here that the foundation of literacy, numeracy and other structures are laid down for the future.

Middle Years

Our Middle school program (**classes 6 to 8**) offers effective transition from middle to high school and then to higher education programs. This stage includes production, demonstration, exhibition, presentation and performances by the students. Students at this stage are ready to exhibit what they have observed over the previous years.

Secondary Years

Our secondary stage starts from classes 9 to 10. At this stage students understand how to set goals. To foster good and responsible behaviour and leadership skills. Teachers motivates them to reach their goal and purpose.

Assessments

Admission Procedure

To register your child for entry in All Saints' Diocesan School, Tezpur, the Registration Form should be completed and returned to the Principal. You can collect the Registration Form in the month of November from the school.

Entry to Higher Classes of All Saints' Diocesan School, Tezpur, is granted on the basis of a written and a qualifying interview. The written test will be in English, Mathematics, Science, Hindi, Assamese, GK, Social Science (class and stream-wise subject might differ). Those candidates who are successful and short-listed will be called for an interview with the Principal. A complete report from the child's present school is required to be presented at the time of interview.

To accept the offer of a seat in the school, a deposit of the 1st instalment of fees is payable. The school office will supply, on request, details of fees and a scale for the payment of fees by quarterly instalments.

While the school reserves the right to alter any fees and payments without any specified notice, it is a normal practice to give a month's notice about such changes.

One full term's notice of the intention to remove a pupil from the school must be given by the Parent/Guardian in writing to the Principal, otherwise a full term's fees will be levied in lieu of notice.

Documents to be submitted at the time of admission:

- School leaving/transfer certificate and previous year's Report Card
- Medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner
- Original and copy of birth certificate (original to be brought for verification copy)

NOTE: Admission will be cancelled if any variance is found between the particulars filled in the Registration Form and the documents submitted for admission.

Academic Session

The academic session for the students commences from April-March, following the Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) system as per CBSE Bye-Laws.
